Implementation Rules for 2026 Global Demonstration Enterprises for the Intelligently Interconnected Digital Economy

I. Solicitation Period

From now until July 31, 2026, 24:00 (Beijing Time).

II. Target Entities

Enterprises operating in sectors based on the IoT digital economy, including but not limited to: Industrial (including Smart Manufacturing), Agriculture, Energy, Logistics, Cultural Tourism, Smart City (Community), Smart Living (including Wearables and Smart Home), Artificial Intelligence, Aerospace, Military-Civilian Technology, Ecological & Environmental Protection, Connected Vehicles, Finance, Security, Health & Healthcare, and Modern Service Industries. Eligible enterprises should possess relevant technological achievements, hardware/software products, solutions, or application service platforms.

III. Selection Methods

Self-nomination by enterprises; recommendations by national/regional governments, agencies, international organizations, and business associations; or selection by World Internet of Things Convention (WIOTC) institutions.

IV. Application Materials

1. Applicants must complete Application Form of 2026 Global Demonstration Enterprises for the Intelligently Interconnected Digital Economy with a signature or official seal. Please send the completed



form and a scanned electronic copy to 365@wiotc.org.

2. Applicants are required to provide introductory materials for IoT digital economy products, solutions, or application services. This includes, but is not limited to: multimedia materials, physical products/items, technical documentation, success stories, presentation materials, annual output value of services, Intellectual Property (IP) documents, qualification/honor certificates, and other relevant supporting evidence.

V. Selection Process

Application for Registration → Preliminary Review → Shortlist Publicity (for public feedback) → Final Review → Official announcement and issuance of certificates and licenses.

VI. Benefits for Global Demonstration Enterprises

1. All registered applicants are entitled to free promotion of their enterprise, products, technologies, and solutions on the official convention website.
2. Enterprise information will be publicized on the WIOTC official website and WeChat official account.
3. Demonstration enterprises will receive priority for membership in relevant digital economy industry committees.
4. Opportunities to receive investment for World IoT digital economy projects, with priority access to investment and cooperation in WIOTC institutions, platforms, and projects.
5. Priority to apply for keynote speeches or participation in high-end dialogues during the World Internet of Things Convention (Annual Meeting) and series of summit events.



6. Eligibility to become a member of WIOTC institutions or the IoT Innovation Alliance (with membership fees waived).

VII. Important Notes

1. Participating units must submit authentic materials and assume all legal and regulatory responsibilities for the truthfulness of the submitted content.
2. If a participating enterprise requires an on-site inspection by selection experts, an application can be submitted to the Organizing Committee. The enterprise shall bear the expert fees and related expenses.
3. Registered products, technologies, solutions, and technological achievements must comply with relevant laws, regulations, and existing standards.
4. Applicants must complete the form and submit materials in strict accordance with the requirements of Application Form of 2026 Global Demonstration Enterprises for the Intelligently Interconnected Digital Economy.
5. Any discovery of fraudulent activity or infringement will lead to disqualification.
6. Application materials can be downloaded from the WIOTC official website (www.wiotc.org).
7. Once all materials are prepared, please place them in a named folder, compress it, and send the package to 365@wiotc.org.
